


How to connect to a VPN (Windows)


1. Download and install FortiClientVPNOnlineInstaller (currently version 7.4 as of early 2025)

2. Run the **FortiClient Installer** installation file. The software will be downloaded and installed.
3. The "Yes, I have read and..." checkbox needs to be enabled when the application launches. Click **Next** after that.




4. Confirm the installation with **Install** button and the process begins.




5. When installed click **Finish**.
6. Then find **FortiClient VPN** in the **Start** menu and launch it.



7. The first window will ask to tick the settings and then click **I accept**. Next, the window offers to configure the VPN.



8. **Configure VPN** window only appears once (if configuration will be correct), but the configuration window can be called up as many times as needed after.
9. Next window is with configurations. Only the most important things are here.



10. **Connection Name** – name of connection (e.g. Viko, Vilnius College). If you have more connections through this tool, it will be easier to figure out which one is which.

Description – Not required.

Remote Gateway – sslvpn.viko.lt.

Check **Customize port** and leave port **443**.


Check **Enable Single Sign On (SSO) for VPN Tunnel**.

Single Sign On Settings appears.


Check **Use external browser as user-agent for saml user authentication**, this check will allow authentication.

Do not choose anything for **Client Certificate**. And click **Save**.


After everything has been done, it should appear as follows:




11. From now on, **ForticlientVPN** should look like this when opened every time:




12. Click **Connect** and when the browser opens, fill in what it asks for, in this case: email and password.



13. Confirm sign it with the **Authenticator** app.



14. If everything is successful, browser should show the following message:



15. A small icon with a lock will appear on the taskbar. Clicking on it will open a context menu with several options, including logging out.
16. You can also disconnect by opening the connection details window, there is a **Disconnect** button.
